Camp dates are July 19-23th
The price of camp is \$215. Please bring two separate checks (see above).
Camper health cards must be filled out before registration. You will be required to turn in one copy for each camper (including sponsors and pastors). The forms you turn in will not be returned to you. If you need a copy for yourself, then photocopy the health form and then duplicate them once your campers have filled them out so that you have two sets. This health form is a lot more detailed than what we are used too. Please note that you need a photocopy of each camper's insurance card. Also, the shot record is more detailed. You may also just photocopy your student's shot records and attach to the health form rather than filling out the form. Counselors over twenty-one only need to fill out the top portion.
Please Note: All health card and camp roster information will be collected in as soon as you drive through the gate and before you can go to your assigned dorm, so please have that all ready to go.
We need to hear from you by June 24th with a ballpark figure so that the camp may plan ahead for ordering food. Please email this count to Theresa at timlindsey@hotmail.com or call her 816-344-2677
We need a more concrete number divided boys and girls by July 8th so that we can divide out the dorms. Please call Theresa cell number to provide those numbers for her.
You must call Camp Minnetonka (Susan or Wesley Morgan) as you pull out of your parking lot Monday morning with your final count. Susan wants to know exactly how many you have coming before you arrive at the camp. Susan 918-569-7856
Please plan to register between 3:00 & 4:00 on Monday, if at all possible. There will be a counselor's meeting in the cafeteria at 4:30. As stated above, you will turn in health forms and the camp roster to Susan as you enter the camp, but at our camp registration is where I will need your competition forms, final count and a check © from you.
Our first meal will be Monday at supper. Our last meal will be Friday at breakfast.
Daily dorm inspections are designed to keep our housekeeping up to health department regulations. A daily contest will reward campers with cleanest area. Please bring name tags to mark your area.
Elsewhere in this packet or on the website you will find a list of rules for the camp. Please read them carefully. I am listing a few here that are of utmost importance.
All junior campers will need a life jacket to swim in the creek. The camp does NOT provide these. You will need to provide your own life jackets.
PRIOR TO ARRIVING each church must provide a current Certificate of Insurance that

names Minnetonka Christian Camp as an additional insured for the group's general Liability, Automobile Coverage for the vehicles brought to the Camp and all other coverage necessary to cover against any claims of abuse, mistreatment or molestation. A simple phone call to your insurance company should take care of this. But **REMEMBER** you **must mail this certificate to the camp prior to arriving**. It would be a good idea to have this mailed in by June 11. If you have any questions do not hesitate to call the camp, ask for Susan Morgan 918-569-7856 and she will explain it to you.

- If you wish to stay in one of the motel rooms you must call Susan Morgan at 918-569-7856 to reserve one. These are limited and require an additional fee on top of the camp fee.
- Please let your kids and parents know ahead of time that all junior campers will only be doing target practice with the paintballs not actually shooting at one another.

✓ Starting Day Of Camp (Monday Morning)

Call as you leave your church parking lot on the way to camp with your <u>exact count</u>, divided boys and girls including sponsors who are sleeping the dorms.

MUSIC COMPETITION

The music competition will include small groups (duets, trios and quartets), solos, and instrumental. Each church may have two entries in each category for 3rd-4-th grade and two entries in each category from 5th-6th grade. Ratings will be based on selection, poise and presentation, pitch and tone. Each church is also welcome of have one group/choir song. The group song will be performed during service time and will not be judged. The camp does not have a piano, therefore there will not be a piano division in the competition.

OBJECT LESSON

This competition is for girls only. Time limit is 2 - 3 minutes. Two entries per church are allowed for each age group (3rd - 4th & 5th - 6th). The object lesson can be presented for (1) 4 -5 year old (2) 1st - 3rd grade or (3) 4th - 6th grade. Entrants will be judged on theme, content, delivery and appropriateness to the age of the audience being taught.

PREACHING

This competition is for boys only. Time limit is 3 - 4 minutes. Two entries per church per age group are allowed. The message should be presented to an elementary age audience. Entrants will be judged on theme, Bible content, delivery and appropriateness to the age level of the audience.

Bible Quiz Rules

- 1. Each team will consist of five members.*****
- 2. Each match will consist of two rounds.
 - a. The first round will be written.

Five questions will be asked

All five team members will have a pad and pencil to write the answer.

There will be one point awarded for each correct answer.

There will be no deduction for a wrong answer.

b. The second round will be a speed round

Ten questions will be asked.

Each team member will have a buzzer with which they may buzz in.

The first one to buzz in will light up the control box, blocking others from buzzing

There will be one point awarded for a correct answer.

There will be one point deducted for an incorrect answer.

The contestants may buzz in at any time

The quizzer will stop reading the question once someone has buzzed in.

- 3. A tie will be broken by the asking of three additional questions.
- 4. Any "Quotes" or anything in "Quotation Marks" must be answered "word perfect"
- 5. Each team member will take a placement test on Monday, immediately following supper, so that the teams may be correctly bracketed. This will be a written test.

*****A team may consist of fewer players, but it will put this team at a definite disadvantage because it hinders you from obtaining all the points possible during the written round.
